Applications on the prescribed form are invited for the appointment of **GUEST TEACHERS** in **ECONOMICS** in the Bridge Course, AMU, Aligarh, on payment of an honorarium as per University Rules. The appointment will be purely temporary till end of the **Academic Session 2021-22** or till the vacancies are filled up whichever is earlier and liable to termination at any time without notice or assignment of reason.

POST: Guest Teacher in Economics (01)

Eligibility (A or B):

(A)

- (i) A Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned/relevant/allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- (ii) A Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time, as the case may be.

Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in the University subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:

- (a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;
- (b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
- (c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
- (d) The Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal;
- (e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D. work in conferences/ seminars sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC/ICSSR/CSIR or any similar agency.

The fulfillment of above conditions is to be certified by the Registrar/Controller of Examinations of the University.

OR

(B)

The Ph.D. degree has been obtained from a foreign university/institution with a ranking among top 500 in the World University Ranking (at any time) by any one of the following: (i) Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) (ii) the Times Higher Education (THE) or (iii) the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai).

NOTE: A relaxation of 5% shall be allowed at the Bachelor's as well as at the Master's level for the candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Other Backward Class (Non-Creamy Layer)/Differently-Abled ((a) Blindness and low vision; (b) Deaf and Hard Hearing; (c) Locomotor disability including cerebral palsy, leprosy cured, dwarfism, acid attack victims and muscular dystrophy; (d) Autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness; (e) Multiple disabilities from amongst persons under (a) to (d) including deaf-blindness) for the purpose of eligibility and assessing Good Academic Record for direct recruitment. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based only on the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedures.

NOTE: At present, University is inviting all eligible candidates for interview for the post of Assistant Professor vide OM D.No. 1093/SC (T) dated 08.09.2018. If the number of candidates for any vacancy become unmanageable in the opinion of the Vice Chancellor, then the University may use

shortlisting criteria as prescribed in the Ordinances. For this purpose, if required, there will be a



Committee of Dean, Chairperson of the concerned Department and one Nominee of the Vice Chancellor.


(The Academic score as specified in **Appendix I** shall be considered for short-listing of the candidates for interview only, and the selections shall be based only on the performance in the interview).

1. The Application Form for the above posts is to be filled only in the **Online Mode** at the Careers Portal of the University <https://careers.amuonline.ac.in>
2. The **non-refundable Processing Fee** for each Application Form is **Rs. 500/-** and is to be paid only in the **Online Mode** at the Careers Portal. However, **PwD candidates are exempted** from payment of prescribed Processing Fee, in case they upload an authentic Disability Certificate on the prescribed Proforma with the Application Form
3. Applicants must follow all the instructions as given in the Advertisement and the User Manual available on the Careers Portal.
4. **After successful submission of the online Application Form, the applicant must:**
 - Take the Printout of the PDF file of the Application Form on A-4 Size paper.
 - Append his/her signature and paste front facing recent photograph at the designated place on the Application Form.
 - Attach attested copies of all relevant documents including Receipt of processing fee, wherever applicable, with the Application Form.
 - Submit the Application Form, complete in all respect in the office of CEPECAMI/ Bridge Course A.M.U. Aligarh.
5. Applications received late or without necessary supporting documents viz., Degrees/Certificates/ Mark Sheets/Experience Certificate etc. or not attested by the Head of the Department/Institution/ Gazetted Officer/self-attested shall be summarily rejected. The University will not be responsible for any late receipt/non-receipt of the Application Form.
6. Incomplete Application Forms or applications on plain paper will not be entertained and shall be summarily rejected.

NOTE: All the eligible candidates will be interviewed in the office of the Director, CEPECAMI/Bridge Course, AMU, Aligarh.
